ORDER DIRECTING THAT AN ELECTION BE HELD WITHIN THE RIVER PARK METROPOLITAN DISTRICT ON THE QUESTION OF DISSOLUTION	

THIS MATTER coming before this Court on a Petition for Dissolution of River Park Metropolitan District and Entry of an Order Directing that an Election be Held Within the River Park Metropolitan District on the Question of Dissolution (the “**Petition**”) filed on behalf of the Board of Directors (the “**Board**”) of the River Park Metropolitan District (“**District**”) in the Town of New Castle, County of Garfield, Colorado (the “**Town**”) pursuant to the provisions set forth in Part 7, Article 1, Title 32, C.R.S., and now being fully advised in the premises,

This Court hereby FINDS the following:

1. This Court has jurisdiction in all matters pertaining to this action as provided by law.
2. The Petition was filed with this Court on June 11, 2025, and is in compliance with all requirements of Part 7, Article 1, Title 32, C.R.S.
3. This Court scheduled and held a hearing on the Petition in accordance with § 32-1-703(2), C.R.S., on July 18, 2025, (the “**Hearing**”), and notice for the Hearing was properly provided in accordance with § 32-1-703, C.R.S.

4. The District has outstanding debt (“**Outstanding Debt**”), and the Board approved a plan for dissolution of the District that includes provisions for the repayment of the District’s Outstanding Debt (the “**Plan for Dissolution**”), which Plan for Dissolution was properly filed with this Court.

5. Pursuant to Section 32-1-704(4)(b), C.R.S., the Plan for Dissolution adequately provides for the payment of the District’s financial obligations, including its Outstanding Debt.

6. Pursuant to § 32-1-704(4)(b), C.R.S., an election is required to dissolve the District because of its Outstanding Debt.

The Court being fully advised in the premises, ORDERS as follows:

1. The question of dissolution of the District shall be submitted to the eligible electors of the District at an election to be held and conducted within the District as a coordinated mail ballot election on November 4, 2025, with the Garfield County Clerk and Recorder serving as the Coordinated Election Official and the results thereof to be determined in the manner provided in Title 1, Article 7, C.R.S.

2. The ballot question to be submitted to the eligible electors of the District shall be in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and incorporated herein by this reference, and as certified by the Coordinated Election Official.

3. The Canvass Board for the District, as appointed by the Coordinated Election Official, shall promptly certify the election returns of the election to this Court.


